

Guidelines for Papers to be published in the Proceedings of the 24th ICHC:

These Guidelines are furnished to authors of papers presented at the 24th ICHC and which will be published in the Proceedings of this Conference. It is important that authors follow these Guidelines as closely as possible so that their paper will (a) appear in its most attractive and interesting form and (b) the time and difficulty in the publishing process is minimized.

1. All manuscripts should be submitted in digital form using Microsoft's WORD word-processing software.
2. All images that are to be included in a paper should be submitted in .jpeg or .tiff digital format. Good quality hard copy of images is acceptable but submission in digital form is better. **Do not submit images directly from Power Point presentations since these images will not reproduce in good quality.** Note: The quality of the image submitted will be reflected in the image that is printed in your paper so please submit good quality images.
3. All manuscripts should be submitted in four parts:
 - a. The main paper.
 - b. List of Figures (images) with captions to each Figure.
 - c. The Figures (images) numbered to match with the captions to these Figures.
 - d. The Tables (if there are any tables)

Be sure to indicate the place where each figure and each table should be placed within the text of the paper.

4. References should be given for all important statements in a paper. The location of these references in the text of the paper should be entered as END NOTES using the Microsoft WORD program's function (on the WORD toolbar) for this purpose.
5. Please keep all formatting of papers to a minimum. The final formatting will be done when the paper is laid-out for publication.
6. Overall Layout of a Paper for Publication in the ICHC Proceedings: Generally, a paper will start with a short INTRODUCTION, followed by the body of the paper that tells the story of the paper. Each paper should end with any ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS and REFERENCES. Please see past published volumes of ICHC Proceedings for examples papers laid out in an acceptable way.

7. Submission of papers: All papers to be published in the proceedings of the 24th ICHC should be sent via email within 60 days of the end of the Conference to:
